We are grateful for all that He is doing and, yet there is an urgent need to proclaim the Gospel further and wider. We had an amazing thing happen recently: two weeks ago at the jail after years of preaching and praying we had seven men respond to the Gospel and make public professions of faith! Follow up is hard in the jail here, so please pray that these men would grow as we continue to preach to them.

Also, be praying for a young man named Kaluui. He and I have recently started a Bible study together. He is obviously searching for a secure relationship with God and we are making good headway. I believe it's only a matter of time until he becomes a Christian.

This past Saturday, after 3 years of hard work and preparation, we had the privilege of conducting the grand opening for the gym! We had a great turn out and lots of fun. Many of our church people prepared and donated food; and the young men I have been coaching came and volunteered to help run some of the competitions. Most importantly, we held a dedication ceremony in which I shared the purpose of the gym and presented the Gospel.

The longer we serve in Chuuk, the more we understand how much your prayers affect what God is doing out here. Thank you for praying; please continue! We do not take lightly the sacrifices of time, finances, and love you make on our behalf. It is our privilege to represent you. Let us continue to do "all the good we can" as we eagerly await Jesus Christ!
