Dear Friends, Prayer Partners, and Faithful Supporters,

God blessed the Bible club rallies on June 3rd, 4th, and 5th, with approximately 4,000 public school children participating, 240 professions of faith, and 146 public school teachers participating in the training. What a joy it was to watch the New Testament Church Pioneers from The Crown College and Temple Baptist Church pray earnestly, and see God answer their prayers so specifically as they worked so hard!

We had a most wonderful Bible Club board meeting in the capital, June 19th and 20th. God has given us great joy in seeing our incredible local partners lead in the work. It is so exciting to see the curriculum continuing to spread across the country. We just received a text from a pastor who saw 32 professions of faith in his school. Please pray as our board members each follow up on different opportunities with local pastors, the education department, and teacher colleges.

This Monday, June 23rd, we will go as a family to Simbai for a training session for public school teachers, followed by training for the pastors at Yomneki. Tim will be dropped off at Simbai while Leandra and the kids fly to Yomneki. Tim will hike the rest of the way to Yomneki after the training at Simbai. Please pray for Tim making the long hike in the evening between the locations.

Please continue to pray for the Bible Clubs, specifically for revival, curriculum, funding, training, and especially follow up on the salvation decisions. A special thank you to our many prayer warriors, supporters, and logistics team.
