

Venezuela

Dear Friends, Prayer Partners, and Faithful Supporters,

We have been so busy, and time just flew by without us realizing that it has been too long since we last sent an update. Venezuela has become an extremely difficult and expensive country to live and minister. There is no functioning government in the country anymore and gold has been discovered in the jungle where we work. This has caused a horrible situation in the Amazon where goods are priced in gold.

We have spent mid-February-May 21 in Puerto Ayacucho tending to sick Yanomamo patients. There has been a baffling increase of tumors in both children and adults needing surgery. Unfortunately, no medical services are provided to help these poor, desperate people. Our funds were depleted taking care of them with their lab work, doctor's visits, buying medicines, surgeries, and keeping them all fed while they recuperated. This took more time than we had anticipated; but it was all in God's timing.

We were finally able to get more funds to make our way to Colombia to work on visas for our granddaughter and great grandson (1 year old) who is needing medical attention. During his delivery, there was a problem, and the right side of his face is paralyzed. Due to the paralysis on that side of his face it has affected his right eye, and he is going blind in that eye. If visas are granted, we plan to take them to the US to get medical treatment in the hopes of saving his eyesight.

Please pray:

- \* for us to get over our colds.
- \* for needed funds to stay longer than we had anticipated.
- \* for us to get the paperwork done for travel to the US.
- \* for visas to be granted for the baby to get the medical attention he needs.
- \* for the spiritual and physical needs of the Yanomamo.

We love and appreciate each one of you! God's richest blessings on you!
