Furlough is flying by! We're very thankful for God's protection over us (and hand upon our vehicle) over thousands of miles. We are thankful for the chance to reconnect with many dear churches that have been supporting us over the course of our ministry in Cambodia. We are thankful for some new churches that have chosen to take us on and have a part in this work. We are thankful for souls that we have seen saved through the preaching of God's Word in churches around America, as well as opportunities to personally lead some young people to Christ. And we are thankful that we have just 3 months in America before we head back to the field! Over these next few months we still have much travel, so please pray for continued safety on the road, and that the Lord will continue to save souls and call out laborers.

Please pray at this time for the political situation in Southeast Asia. Over the last couple of weeks, there has been a series of border clashes between Thailand and Cambodia. The fighting has left many dead and many more displaced. Although there is currently a ceasefire, tensions remain high. We ask you to pray for those affected by the war on both sides, and that a permanent peace can be reached.
