Caleb is a junior now and is studying Criminal Justice. He desires to make a difference for the cause of Christ in the Law Enforcement field. Anna is studying Graphic Design and is a freshman. With the skills she learns, she wants to be able to help local churches with websites, invitations, and gospel tracts. We miss them both tremendously! They are such a big part of our family and ministry and were such a great help with church plant needs.

We have run into a few difficulties lately. We returned home from our big road trip to a mess as our chest freezer in the garage had stopped working. We kept meat there that we bought in bulk, and it was all bad. Right before we left, our refrigerator had stopped working. We lost some food then, but we tried to salvage some by putting it in the – you guessed it – garage freezer. So, please pray for us for wisdom about meals. A mechanic looked at the fridge today (now that we are home) and said it will be at least a week until he can get the parts to fix it. We have also had several major car repairs over this time and still have more to repair. Last month, Ethan broke his nose and required surgery.
